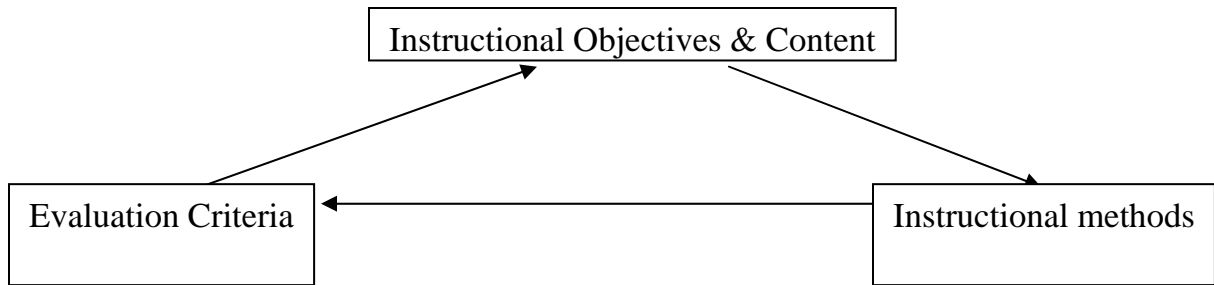

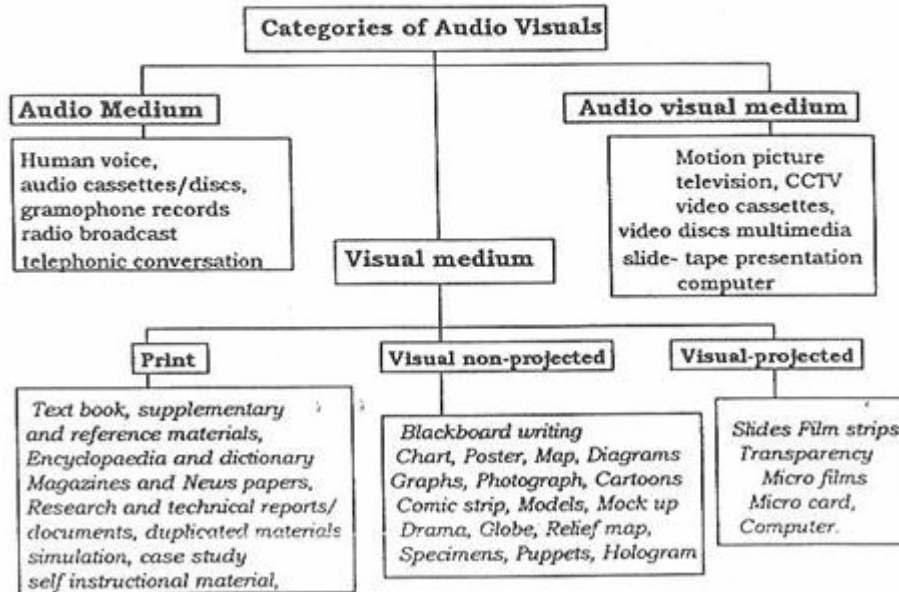

Factors to be kept in mind while selecting the audio visuals.

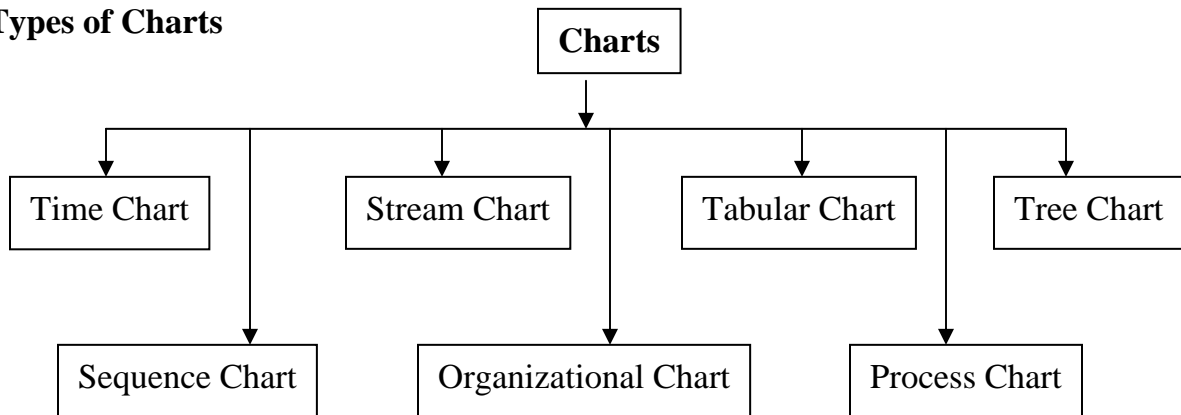
1. appropriateness for the age group (learners characteristics)

3. utility.
4. the degree of concreteness required.
5. time available.
6. feasibility and cost.
